Theme Description

Artists are invited to submit work for National Parks, an exhibition celebrating the enduring legacy, natural beauty, and cultural significance of the United States National Park System. This exhibit honors the vision that preserved some of the nation’s most treasured landscapes for future generations.

Coined as “America’s Best Idea,” the national parks represent a commitment to conservation, public access, and shared heritage. From majestic mountains and expansive deserts to historic landmarks and protected ecosystems, these spaces embody the spirit of exploration, stewardship, and national identity. We are including National Monuments in this call.

Submission Requirements

- ◆ Open to artists residing in Arizona, 18 years and older.
- ◆ Accepted mediums: painting, drawing, printmaking, mixed media, glass, photography, giclées of paintings, ceramic and sculpture in both traditional approaches and new techniques.
- ◆ Work must be available for exhibit and must be for sale. Once selected, no substitutions will be accepted. Artwork will remain on display for duration of exhibit.
- ◆ Weight limit of 50 lbs if piece will be installed on wall.
- ◆ Artwork will not be accepted mounted on foam core alone.
- ◆ **All artwork must be wired with plastic coated picture wire and ready to hang on a wire and hook system.** Please put wire hangers horizontally on the back. Wire should be placed no more than 1/3 of the way down from the top of the frame and pulled taut.
- ◆ Work must not exceed \$3,000 per piece. The Herberger Theater receives a 30% donation for its youth and community outreach programs from all artwork purchased. Consider this carefully when pricing work, as prices listed on application cannot be changed once selected. Artwork is insured for duration of exhibit.

Selection Process

Curators are Connie & A O Tucker. Work is selected using a blind jury process. Criteria to include: Adequacy to the Theme, Originality and Quality of Execution.

There are TWO options to apply:

1. Submit online through our website, click here.

2. Submit by mail using this application. Include up to six images, bio and artist information form on a flash drive (preferred) or CD.

- ◆ Before submitting images online or saving them to a flash drive/CD, please name your images in the following format: lastname_firstname_title
- ◆ Each image must be 300dpi, minimum of 4”x6” in JPG or PNG. When submitting photos, please ensure photo is taken straight-on, without an angle, and cropped to the edge of the piece.
- ◆ \$25.00 non-refundable fee for up to six images. If applying on website, use online payment link or **click here to pay.**
