Aaron made New York City his base after graduating with a BFA in Musical Theatre from Northern Kentucky University, where he has performed on Broadway (*Spider-Man: Turn Off the Dark*), Off-Broadway (*Rent*), Broadway Tours (*Jesus Christ Superstar*, *Rent*), with Symphonies, in Lower East Side rock clubs, on the high seas, & in concert halls across multiple continents. Aaron was selected by Kelly Clarkson (Team Kelly!) on Season 29 of NBC's *The Voice*. Portraying Jesus in the 50th Anniversary Tour Andrew of Lloyd Weber's *Jesus Christ Superstar* was a true honor. 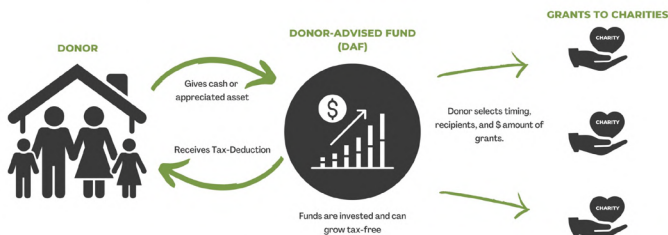

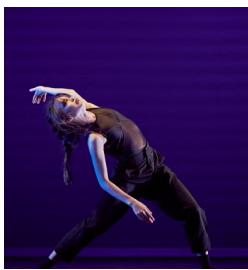
How a Donor-Advised Fund Works





YOUTH EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Herberger Theater provides arts experiences and cultural enrichment for children in our community. With your help, we will continue to reach underserved youth and open their imagination to the magic of live performing arts.



ARIZONA YOUNG ARTISTS' COMPETITION

The competition showcases the diverse and emerging talent of young Arizona artists, introduces them to the audition process, and provides them with an opportunity to interact with highly-regarded arts professionals. Students, ages 15-21, compete in the areas of Acting, Dance, Classical Voice and Musical Theatre Voice for an opportunity to win a scholarship to help further their education in the arts.



ARTS 360: IN-SCHOOL EDUCATION PROGRAM

Arts 360 is an arts education initiative dedicated to integrating the performing arts into early childhood learning. By bringing live performance and arts-based instruction directly into classrooms, the interactive program ensures that all children, regardless of financial means or transportation access, can experience the transformative power of the arts.



CAMP 360 JUNE 1-12, STAGE WEST

Camp 360, a collaboration between the Herberger Theater and Art Heals Arizona, gives teens in group homes, shelters, and treatment programs the chance to explore the arts through a two-week camp. Participants engage in theater activities like improv, costumes, props, and tech, culminating in a performance that shares their personal stories through poetry, music, movement, and storytelling.

A free outdoor series that celebrates the depth and variety of Arizona's talent and provides high-quality music, dance and theatrical programming in a welcoming environment. The series showcases performances that are diverse and reflective of our community.

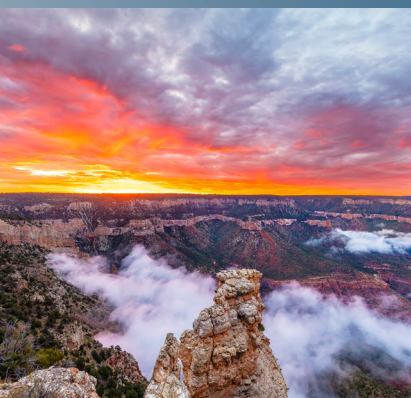
